Main Street, Alliance, OH 44601, or they may be downloaded from <http://www.cfainc.org/Portals/0/documents/forms/16-17show-rules.pdf>. All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), Agility (if offered), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pet, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with an Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. \*Show rule 2.19E The MISCELLANEOUS (Non-Competitive) CLASS is for any registered cat or registered kitten of a breed not accepted for Provisional Breed competition. Miscellaneous Class entries are examined by judges; however, no awards will be made in this class. All Bengal championship, premiership and kitten entries can enter under a TRN, but all Bengals in the show hall must be registerable, (5 generation pedigree with no wild blood). Sainly City Cat Club, Inc. reserves the right to add judges not named to judge Non- Championship and Non-Premiership classes.

A list of parking information and a map will be sent along with your entry confirmation. The show hotel is The Best Western Capital Ridge - 161 St. Anthony Ave. St. Paul, MN 55103 651-227-8711. A block of rooms has been set aside, just mention you are with the Sainly City cat show. Rate: \$139.00 plus tax (2 Queen or King). Breakfast included and free shuttle to and from the RiverCentre.

It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, calici viruses and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. Any entry from a house or cattery where there has been fungus or any infectious or contagious illness within 21 days prior to the show is prohibited from entry in the show hall. All claws of each entry must be clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats and kittens may not be entered. All Household Pet entries over the age of 8 months must be spayed or neutered.

No kittens under the age of 4 months will be allowed in the show hall. Exhibitors must have litter registration available in the show hall to verify age of kittens. Cats and kittens not entered in the show, or in prearranged sales cages, will not be permitted in the show hall.

Supplies: Exhibitors should bring cat food, dishes and litter pans for their cats. Litter will be provided by the show. The show hall is heated, but we recommend bringing warm curtains or towels for the inside of your cage.

Cages: Approximate size is 21" x 21" x 21" (single cage, one-half of a double wire cage, included with entry). Second entry by same owner will be benching in the other half of a double cage, or the other half may be purchased for extra \$20 (noted as extra half cage), as available. Exhibitors using security cages must purchase extra half cage if exhibiting one cat in the cage. Single security cage spaces are not available.

Awards: Ribbons and rosettes will be awarded according to CFA Show Rules.

Reasonable care will be taken for all cats and personal property, but the Show Management cannot be held responsible for anything lost or damaged. Show Management will ask anyone with misbehaving or disruptive children to remove them from the show hall.

The Show Committee asks that benching requests be held to one per entrant. We will try to honor as many requests as space will allow. Clerks will be paid in accordance with CFA Show Rules.
